



Cruise the Cape

If it's a different landscape you seek on your next break, then how about hopping aboard the EEI and view Tropical North Queensland from the water.

Like an early explorer, you will discover the scenic route from Mackay to Cairns, Thursday Island, Weipa, Cape York and Princess Charlotte Bay.

On this very special expedition we will depart Mackay in the beginning of October 2008 headed for Cairns, a wonderful seven day journey interrupted by fishing, snorkelling and diving as we venture up the Queensland east coast.

Some guests will choose to depart the EEI at Cairns and others will join us, with no more than 28 guests aboard at any one time. Make a group booking or book individual berths. We will travel to Thursday Island for the next ten days, continue on to Weipa, and enjoy sights rarely seen from the water.

Staying on the west coast of Cape York til late October, we will then travel from Thursday Island back to Cairns. Out to Princess Charlotte Bay for a few days, back to Cairns and then back to Mackay via the beautiful and isolated Coral Sea. Every time we stop in Cairns guests have a choice of departing the vessel or joining us for our trip. Register early to avoid disappointment.

WHERE: Mackay to Weipa and back.

WHEN: Depart Mackay 1 October 2008, stopping in Cairns, arrive back in Mackay on 1 December 2008.

HOW MANY: 16-28 guests, either group bookings or individual berths.

COST: \$500 +GST per day per person, includes some fishing gear, accommodation, snorkeling gear and all meals. Does not include alcohol, diving gear or tender use.
